





3. Northern California Woodworking Show being held in San Mateo on November 9th, 10th, and 11th. The entries in the "2 x 4" contest will be displayed as well as members' other woodworking projects.

The "2 x 4" contest is really a fun thing, plus there are quality prizes for first, second and third place.

The rules are as follows:

1. Use your creative talents to turn out a project using a single 2" \times 4" board no longer than eight feet, and using any species of wood. No mixing of woods is permitted.

There are no design restrictions.

3. Any type(s) fasteners (except nails) may be used.

4. Any type(s) of operable/ornamental hardware may be used.

5. No other materials such as plexiglass or plastic laminates may be used. This is an excellent time to start planning for the above events—time is a speed demon.

Whatever your project, do it with safety in mind.

The "show and tell" portion of our meetings can be very enjoyable as well as educational. Bring in your woodworking projects, jigs and fixtures, unusual tools, shop methods for solving or doing a job easier, or anything else that would be of interest to the membership.

If you have a woodworking problem of any kind, present it at the meeting


and we will do our best to help solve it.





Bay Area Woodworkers Association was formed early in 1982 by a small group of dedicated people who felt the need to strengthen the woodworking community by holding regular meetings, establishing an informal forum for the exchange of knowledge and ideas, sponsoring shows, and meeting others in woodworking and related fields. Since then, this non-profit organization has grown to many members. Meetings occur in the third week of each month at 7:00 p.m. and are generally held in San Francisco or Oakland/Berkeley area. Meetings usually have a specific topic such as router techniques, finishing, turning, business aspects of woodworking, or focus on a distinguished guest speaker who will give a presentation in their area of expertise. Most meetings are held in members shops, or the place of business of a guest presenter. Members receive a monthly newsletter.

Dues are \$30 per year payable in January, \$22.50 payable April -June, \$15.00 payable July-September, \$7.50 payable Oct.-December.
